### Find the most convenient way of travel to Ruaha!

The problem with true wilderness is that it is far and hard to get to, that's what makes it wilderness! Ruaha is a long way from civilization, however access to the Park is not impossible there you reach Ruaha by both air and road. The journey is worth it as once you get here you will have made it to one of the last remaining, true, safari wildernesses on the African continent. Once at Msembe HQ/Airstrip, please note there is at least another 3-4 hrs of driving time to get to the outer extremes of the Park where Kichaka calls home.



### BY AIR

Scheduled flights from either **Arusha** or **Dar-Es-Salaam** are daily and drop you right in the middle of the Park where we can collect you. Coastal aviation and Safari Airlink both do frequent flights into the Ruaha. **Please book MSEMBE Airstrip in the Ruaha National Park.** Please bear in mind the approximate flight times below are direct, very often your plane will stop at other strips on the way increasing overall flight time.

- The weight of luggage is restricted to 15kg for checked baggage. Only soft-sided luggage is permitted.
- All of Kichaka Expeditions camps use Msembe Airstrip in Ruaha National Park.
- **Dar es Salaam – Ruaha:** approximately 2 hour 30 min
- **Arusha – Ruaha:** approximately 3 hour 15 min

### BY ROAD

Driving to Ruaha National Park is certainly possible however not recommended. A 4X4 is vital for getting to the Park from Iringa. From Dar-Es-Salaam it is a long two day drive with either a stop over in Mikumi National Park or Iringa Town. Again please bear in mind we are a further 3-4 Hrs drive from the Park gate.

- **From Dar es Salaam to Ruaha Gate:** approximately 12 hours travel time (+/- 700km).
- **From Iringa to Ruaha Gate:** approximately 2-3 hours (+/- 200km).
